- Consider issues raised by members of the community about Peninsula Quarries' operations
- Review and analyse the register of complaints
- Establish and administer the community grants program

An independent chair, Mr Rob Gerrand, has been appointed to lead the new group (please see media release for information about Mr Gerrand) and recruitment is now underway for new members.

RECRUITMENT

Peninsula Quarries is now recruiting members for the Peninsula Quarries Community Engagement Group (PQCEG).

The committee will meet initially in Carrum Down. Meetings will initially be monthly so that members can learn about Peninsula Quarries' operations and the state processes that regulate quarrying at Pottery Road. It is envisaged that meetings will then be on a quarterly or on an as needs basis.
